The Medical Doctor/Surgeon is most often asked to rate the severity of impairment in terms of a percentage loss to the "whole person" and according to criteria specific to each disability system. Often, the impairment percentage so derived, is then directly translated into a monetary sum for purposes of compensating these losses to injured persons. AMA Guides empowers you to do that.
